September 12 – 1 Kings 17 Elijah: A Heart God is Seeking

Discussion Questions:

1. What's one thing that stood out to you from the sermon?
2. What was the situation of Israel at the time of Elijah (1 Kings 17)?
3. Reggie mentioned that the story of Elijah represents a clash of irreconcilable worldviews. What comes to mind when you think of the word: "worldview"? What are the main assumptions of the Christian worldview?
4. How does the prevalent worldview of our culture clash with that of the Bible and of Elijah?
5. Those of you that have heard the story of Elijah before; what does Elijah mean to you?
6. What place does Elijah have in the entire story of God's people?
7. Have you ever had to speak truth to people in power? How did it go for you?
8. Can you relate to Elijah's courageous faith in speaking truth to King Ahab?

9. Two things that are foundational to how we see the world are **a proper view of God**, and a **proper view of self**. Why is it important for Christians to have a proper view of God?
10. What are some ways our view of God gets distorted?
11. What about our view of ourselves. What impact does that have on how we view the world? In your life, what ways has your view of self been distorted by the world or by the culture around you?
12. What courageous prayers ought we to be praying for ourselves, our church, and our world?
