STEP 1: COME TOGETHER: CIRCLE TIME, WORSHIP TIME, BIBLE STORY TIME

Stuff You Need:

Bibles

Pass out the Bibles and sing "The B-I-B-L-E". "The B-I-B-L-E,
Yes, that's the book for me!
I stand alone on the Word of God,
The B-I-B-L-E."

- Have the children look for the picture of Jesus inside their Bibles.
- Collect the Bibles.

Tell the Story:

People make wrong choices, but God had a very good plan. God sent Jesus to earth because He loves us. Not everyone loved Jesus, though. Some people wanted to hurt Jesus. Jesus went to a garden with His friends to pray. Jesus was very sad. He prayed to God, "Father, I will do Your plan." Then men came to take Jesus away. The leaders of the people said things about Jesus that were not true, and they punished Jesus by putting Him on a cross. Jesus died, but three days later, God made Jesus alive again! Jesus showed His friends that He is alive, and Jesus is still alive today.

SING A SONG

(Sing the second verse of "Jumping Up and Down")
Jesus is alive, Jesus is alive,
Jesus is alive, shout "Hosanna!" "Hosanna!"

Say: Jesus died on the cross, but God made Jesus alive again. **JESUS IS ALIVE!** Hosanna!

Pray: Let's pray now and tell Jesus thank you for dying for us and for rising again! (Pray)

STEP 2: CRAFT TIME

ATTENTION TEACHERS: Each week in this unit, every child will make craft 1 during the first service they attend. If they have extra time, all first hour children may color on a blank piece of paper. A coloring sheet may be sent home with each child attending first hour only.

If a child is staying for an additional service, he may color a coloring sheet while the other children are making their craft.

Craft Activity: Resurrection Eggs

Supplies needed:

- Easter Eggs
- "The Tomb is Empty He is not here!" strips
- Sharpie

Classroom Directions:

- 1. Children stick the sentence strip inside their Easter egg.
- 2. Write the child's name on the outside of the Easter egg.
- 3. Ask the children if they see Jesus. No! He is not in the tomb! The tomb is empty! **Jesus is alive!**

STEP 3: SNACK TIME

During snack time, please put a "What I Learned Today" label on their backs. Review the story as they eat. You might also want to repeat the song together. Say, all together, "JESUS IS ALIVE!"

STEP 4: WRAP-UP TIME

SLEEP AND WAKE UP

Invite children to lay down, close their eyes, and pretend to be asleep. When you say, "Good morning!" invite them to sit up and open their eyes.

SAY: When Jesus' friends went to bed on Friday and Saturday night, they were sad. But on Sunday morning, they woke up and saw Jesus! **JESUS IS ALIVE** forever!
