Icebreaker Question:

1. What's one common behavior that to you is unforgiveable?
2. What's one thing that is criminally overpriced to you?
3. What movie have you seen more than 7 times?

Sermon Discussion:

4. Was there one thing that stood out to you from the sermon?
5. Describe a time in your life where you were the recipient of someone else's forgiveness. How did it affect you?
6. Describe a time in your life where you had to forgive someone. What helped you find the power to forgive?
7. People often talk about forgiveness as something that happens in stages, or as a "process." But biblical forgiveness seems to happen at once. Do you think forgiving people that have wronged us is a one-time event, or is it a process? Is it both?
8. Do you think it's harder to give forgiveness or to receive it? Why?
9. Pastor Reggie talked about how carrying unforgiven sin is a burden. In your experience, do you find this to be true? Why or why not?
10. What prevents us from confessing our sin?

11. Have you ever experienced “godly sorrow” over your sin? The Bible says, “godly sorrow leads to repentance.” Is there an area of your life where you felt genuine sorrow over your actions, attitudes, or sin in which God led you to repentance?
12. If godly sorrow is something that the Holy Spirit does in our lives, who do you need to pray for in your life to experience God’s sorrow?
