



Life Group Discussion Guide

April 5: Easter --- One More Move

Icebreaker:

What are some of your favorite Easter memories? Are there specific family traditions you had or created that are especially meaningful?

Discussion Questions:

Every group is different! As you prepare, choose the questions that best fit your group, focusing on those that spark meaningful conversation. Don't rush—depth is better than distance. Trust the Holy Spirit to lead your discussion!

Big Idea: When life is in checkmate, the King has one more move.

1. Do you have a defining moment in your life? Something that changed your trajectory or significantly established who you are? What was it and why?
2. What makes it hard to see God still has a move when life feels like "checkmate"? How does the resurrection of Jesus challenge the way we see our situation?
3. **The King Renews Your Peace:**
 - a. **Read John 20:19-21.**
 - b. What do Jesus' scars tell us about His character?
 - c. What does this teach us about the kind of peace He offers? How is that different from how we usually try to find peace?
4. **The King Renews Your Dignity:**
 - a. Dave said "*the scene of your worst moment, with Jesus, can become the scene of your restoration.*" Why do you think Jesus took the time to recreate a similar setting of Peter's failure to restore him?
 - b. What does that tell you about how Jesus might deal with your own failures?

5. **The King Renews Your Purpose:**
 - a. **Read John 21:15-17.** Why do you think Jesus asked Peter if he loved Him before giving him his purpose? Do you think the order of that matters and why?
 - b. Where are you tempted to go "back to fishing"--back to what's familiar or self-reliant? How do we fight against this temptation?
 - c. What might it look like for you to personally "feed my sheep?" Are there some ways you can go deeper in your care of or investment in others?

6. Which of these do you believe you might need most right now: **Peace, Dignity, or Purpose?** What would it look like to let Jesus to speak into that area this week, trusting He has one more move?

7. **How Does the Resurrection Move from History to Your Story:**
 - a. How can the truth of the resurrection move from something you believe to something you live?
 - b. Close in prayer, asking the Holy Spirit to help you:
 - i. Trust what Jesus has done
 - ii. Love Him in return
 - iii. Follow where He leads
