



# Life Group Discussion Guide

## April 19: Can I Ask That? How to Know the Will of God

### Icebreakers:

What's a decision you made that felt really important at the time, but now seems small or even funny?

When you look back on your life, what's one decision that significantly shaped who you are today?

### Discussion Questions:

*Every group is different! As you prepare, choose the questions that best fit your group, focusing on those that spark meaningful conversation. Don't rush—depth is better than distance. Trust the Holy Spirit to lead your discussion!*

**Big Idea:** Decisions Matter: You decide, and in turn, the decision shapes you.

1. When it comes to decision-making, where do you tend to get stuck? (overthinking, fear of getting it wrong, rushing, etc.)
2. How do you decide when a decision needs extra attention? Do you need to seek God's will on every decision? What role does prayer play in this decision-making?
3. Why is it important to start with what God has already said in Scripture when making decisions?
4. Where do you see growth in your ability to make wiser decisions over time? Where do you still feel immature or unsure?
5. Do you tend to think of God's will more like "train tracks" or an "umbrella"? Why?
6. What feels risky or uncomfortable about believing God gives you freedom in decisions?
7. How could your decisions become an act of worship instead of a source of pressure or fear?
8. Have you experienced God giving clarity or direction over time? What was that like?
9. Who are the people you trust to speak into your decisions?

10. What would it look like for you to hold your plans with open hands this week?

11. Close in prayer. (Leader note: Many people are quietly carrying anxiety about "missing God's will." Help them feel the freedom the sermon is offering.)
