



# Life Group Discussion Guide

## May 3: Exodus 3 --- The Promise of God's Presence

### Icebreakers:

What do you remember of your own high school graduation or other such milestone moment? Was there a ceremony and if so, what sticks with you from it?

### Discussion Questions:

*Every group is different! As you prepare, choose the questions that best fit your group, focusing on those that spark meaningful conversation. Don't rush—depth is better than distance. Trust the Holy Spirit to lead your discussion!*

- 1. Read Exodus 3:1-6.**
  - a. What is the significance of Moses removing his shoes before he came closer to the bush?
  - b. How does the holiness of God change how we approach Him even now?
2. God introduces Himself to Moses by telling him that He's the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Moses likely knew the stories of these men.
  - a. What do you think He might have quickly recalled about God in this moment?
  - b. What had God already revealed about Himself through his relationship with these men and their families?
3. Our God is a God of promise. He makes them, keeps them and even reminds us of His promises when we forget.
  - a. Can you think of a specific promise of God that has helped you in a difficult season? How did it change the way you responded?
4. When you face something difficult, do you tend to focus more on what God is asking you to do, or who is with you? Why?
5. Similarly, do you find yourself focusing more on your own inadequacies or on God's capability? What does that look like in real life?

6. Do you have a "staff" that you come back to that reminds you of God's presence and God's goodness? Is it a particular story, verse(s) or a song? How intentional are you about going back to these things when fear or doubt creep in?
7. Which is harder for you right now: trusting God's plan or trusting that God can use you? Why?
8. Our culture says confidence in yourself is the key to overcoming challenges. How does Moses' story challenge that idea? What does it suggest we actually need?
9. **Read 2 Corinthians 12:7-10.**
  - a. How does Paul expound on the way that Christians ought to view weaknesses and hardships?
  - b. How is God's work in us in this way a grace we can be grateful for?
10. If you really believed that God was with you wherever He sends you, what would change in your life right now?
