# June 23 – 1 Peter 4 – Fellowship & Hospitality

# Icebreaker:

If you had to give a speech about any topic with only five minutes to prepare, what topic would you choose?

# **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Ask someone to read aloud **1 Peter 4:8-10**.
  - a. What stands out to you from this text?
  - b. What stood out to you from the sermon on Sunday?

## 2. Biblical Hospitality

- a. Randy explained that the word for "hospitality" literally means "the love of strangers." It is about loving people and caring for them, not just entertaining them. How do you tend to define what hospitality looks like? Did this passage change your perspective on what hospitality can be?
- b. Randy said the Gospel, and discipleship, and friendship, and a deeper love, travel well on a table. Can you think of a time when you experienced or practiced this concept? How did that impact you and the other people involved?

## 3. Hospitality in the Bible

- a. Ask members of your group to read Luke 10:1-12, Romans 12:10-13, and Hebrews 13:1-2.
- b. How do these passages illustrate the importance of hospitality? What could it look like for you to show this kind of Biblical hospitality in your own life?

# 4. The Invisible Fence

- a. Randy used the illustration of an invisible fence to talk about how we create barriers and limits to our hospitality. What are some barriers you put up in your own life and how might they be keeping you from deeply connecting with others?
- b. What could you do to overcome some of these barriers?

## 5. Hospitality Challenge

a. Randy challenged us to practice a "radically normal hospitality" for the next 30 days. For us to commit to live out **1 Peter 4:8-9.** What are some ways that you can commit to live out Biblical hospitality over the next month?

## 6. Closing Commitments

- a. What barriers to hospitality will you tear down this week?
- b. If you choose to accept the 30-day hospitality challenge. Share with your group what you commit to do over the next month to show Biblical hospitality.
