



# Life Group Discussion Guide

## June 2 – 1 Peter 1 – Exiles: Living from the Margins

### Icebreaker:

What is your favorite breakfast cereal?

### Discussion Questions:

1. Randy described the Christian life as being an "exile or foreigner".
  - In what ways have you seen Christians understand and act upon this positively?
  - Negatively?
  - What was the reason for the difference?
2. How have you seen the culture shift from accommodating Christianity toward more hostile in your life or the lives of those around you? What is the best way to respond as Christ would have us to?
3. In what ways does this shift bring a grieving and a hope in Christ?
4. If someone looked at your life, in what ways would they see that you are different from those who do not serve Christ as Lord?
  - Are there areas you need to be different that you currently are not?
  - (Leader note: We are only as good as we are honest. There may be hundreds of different answers for this, so be prepared to split by gender if appropriate.)
5. Randy spoke of the blessings of being an exile – of the 5, which was most encouraging to you today? Why?
  - We are God's elect: chosen by the Father, sanctified by the Holy Spirit, in order to be obedient to Jesus Christ through his atonement.
  - God's mercy and new birth brings you into a living hope.
    - Why does it matter that the hope is living and active? How can you partner with God to make it so in your life?
  - You have a future inheritance in Christ, reserved in heaven.

- God's power shields you—"you make be a long way from home, but not a long way from Him."
- God is using/will use your hard situation.

6. How are you anticipating God to work in and through your life in light of being a foreigner or exile?
