

Life Group Discussion Guide

June 9 – 1 Peter 1:13-21 – Being the Real Deal

Icebreaker:

Reflect on C.S. Lewis' quote about the irresistible nature of true holiness. Have you ever encountered someone whose holiness was so genuine it drew you closer to God? Share your experience.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Ask someone to read 1 Peter 1:13-21 aloud. What stands out to you from this text?
- 2. Share a time when you were faced with an ethical crossroads. How did your Christian foundations (or lack thereof) guide your actions and decisions?
- 3. What does it look like to live in alignment with the "central, core, immovable truth of the God that exists?"
- 4. Peter writes to those who are "exiles to the world, but precious to God." Share a time when you have lived through "being an exile in the world but valued by God."
- 5. In 1 Peter 1:13, we are commanded to set our hope fully on the grace that will be brought at the revelation of Jesus Christ. What ideas do you have for practical steps we can take to keep our minds focused on this hope?
- 6. Fair warning: this question may require an increased level of vulnerability to answer. What obstacles do you face in striving for holiness?
- 7. 1 Peter 1:17-18 speaks about conducting ourselves with fear throughout our time of exile. What does this fear look like in a healthy, biblical sense, and how can it positively impact our relationship with God?

- 8. Discuss the differences between living a holy life out of gratitude versus legalism. How can we ensure our motivations align with gratitude rather than legalistic obligation?
- 9. The sermon emphasizes serious, focused discipleship. What responsibility or actions do you need to take to "gird the loins of your mind" and ensure your discipleship is intentional and undistracted?
