1. Begin by reading **1 Corinthians 6.**

- 2. If the data is in, and if common sense suggests that limitations to freedom are in fact good for us, why do we naturally push back on those limitations? What drives our desire for unrestrained freedom?
- 3. What did you think of "Roger's" write up regarding Freedom and Responsibility being twins? What do you think he meant when he said that if one dies, they both die? Do you think that rings true?
- 4. How did the Corinthian church abuse their freedom in Christ? How are we similar or different today?
- 5. Read **Hebrews 11:23-28**. Discuss the choices Moses made. Of these various choices which strikes you as the most challenging or inspiring?
- 6. Randy said that "sin will always take you further than you intended to go, keep you longer than you intended to stay, and costs you more than you intended to pay." How do we become more honest about our intentions? How do we become more insightful about where our intentions lead?
- 7. How does **1 Corinthians 6:11** offer hope to those of us caught in the traps mentioned in verses 9-11 or traps not mentioned in these verses? Discuss what this verse is describing and why we should keep its truth in the forefront of our minds.
- 8. What action steps can we take when we realize we are attempting to serve two masters?
