Read 1 Samuel 17:1-11

- 1. How did Saul's army react to the challenge from Goliath? (1 Samuel 17:11)
- 2. How did Saul react to the challenge from Goliath?
- 3. What circumstances can make a group of people lose heart?

Read 1 Samuel 17:26-40

- 4. In David's view, why should the Israelites not have been intimidated by Goliath? (1 Samuel 17:26)
- 5. What happened when David tried on Saul's armor? (1 Samuel 17:38-39)
- 6. How did David end up arming himself for the confrontation with Goliath? (1 Samuel 17:40)
- 7. As with David with Saul's armor, can you think of a time when you tried to be like someone else instead of being yourself? How did it go? What did you learn?

Read 1 Samuel 17:41-54

- 8. In verses 46 and 47, what reasons does David give that the LORD will save the Israelites and deliver Goliath into David's hand?
- 9. In what sense is there a fine line between bravery and stupidity?

- 10. What viewpoint on spiritual warfare can give courage to the seemingly helpless?
- 11. In the story of David and Goliath, what "weapons" were the most powerful?
- 12. In what concrete way can you confront a "giant" problem or trouble with faith?
