July 27 – 1 Samuel 27 --- Under the Circumstances

Icebreaker:

What's a time you took a shortcut that seemed smart at first but ended up backfiring or surprising you?

Discussion Questions:

A. Read 1 Samuel 27

David was known for slaying the Goliath the Philistine, and here he is seeking refuge among the Philistines from the hand of Saul. David said, "The best thing I can do is to escape to the land of the Philistines."

- 1. Can you think of a similar season in your life where you blended in among people of the world because they never found out about your faith?
 - o What led you into that situation?
 - o What led you out of that situation?
 - o Did it work out well? In the short term? In the long term?
- 2. How does worldly success blind us to our lack of faithfulness to God and His word?

B. Read Hebrews 3:13

The philosophy of pragmatism says that something is true if it works. David's time living among the Philistines appeared to work to preserve his life from the hand of Saul.

- 3. In your own life, how has sin deceived you into thinking you were doing the right thing?
- 4. How do we guard against being deceived by sin?
- 5. What should we do to see God's truth clearly?

C. Read Psalm 32

6. In this Psalm, what are the bad actions and their consequences that David describes?

- 7. What are the good actions and their consequences?
- 8. What does Psalm 32 tell us about God?
- 9. In what ways does this story and Psalm convict you or challenge you?
- 10. What will you do this week to act on what you have learned from God's Word?
