August 17: 1 John 1:5-7 --- God is Light...Walk in it Him!

Icebreaker:

What's one time you've been in complete darkness, like no-light-at-all darkness? How did it make you feel, and what did you do?

- 2. Read 1 John 1:5-7.
 - a. What does this passage teach us about God?
 - i. How does the image of light help you to understand God?
 - b. In your words, how would you explain the terms "light" and "darkness" from this passage?
 - c. What inconsistency did John address in 1 John 1:6? What does he mean?
- 3. Read John 3:19-21.
 - a. Why do people refuse to walk in the light?
 - b. What are ways we walk in darkness?
 - c. What is the solution to our walking in darkness?
 - d. Why might it be hard for someone to admit being wrong about something?
 - e. How should we respond when light reveals that we are walking in darkness?
 - f. How do you want others to treat you when they find you walking in darkness?

- g. What does it mean to walk in the light?
- h. What results from walking in the light?
- 4. What is one practical step you can take this week to "walk in the light" in a specific area of your life, and who can help keep you accountable?
