December 28: Joshua 4:19-24 --- Resolute

# **Icebreakers:**

What was your New Year's resolution for 2025? How did it go?

# **Discussion Questions:**

Every group is different! As you prepare, choose the questions that best fit your group, focusing on those that spark meaningful conversation. Don't rush—depth is better than distance. Trust the Holy Spirit to lead your discussion!

**Big idea:** A resolute life is built on visible faith.

#### 1. Introduction

a. Before we read from Joshua 4, what is the history that preceded the crossing of the Jordan river?

#### 2. Read Joshua 4:19-24

- a. Where did Joshua set up the stones?
- b. What was the purpose of the stones?
- c. What did Joshua instruct the people to remember?

#### 3. Read Psalm 103:2-5

- a. In the sermon, the first component of a visible faith is to remember what God has already done.
- b. In the Joshua passage the stones served as a memorial of God's faithfulness at the Jordan river. What are your stones? That is to say, what stories of God's faithfulness in your life do you keep going back to?
- c. How often do you revisit the stones or talk about them to others?
- d. What story of God's faithfulness do you want to share with others so they can take it with them?

### 4. Read Joshua 5:9 and Joel 2:12-13

- a. What from your past have you not moved past?
- b. What Giants are you facing that you are making bigger than God?

## 5. Takeaway

- a. What are your faith stones from 2025?
- b. If you feel comfortable sharing, what did you write down during the time at the end of the sermon?
