



Life Group Discussion Guide

October 6 – 2 Corinthians 10 – Christ Conquers Corinth

Icebreaker:

Tell your best airport or TSA story.

Discussion Questions:

1. Ask someone to read **2 Corinthians 10: 1-6** aloud.
2. As you listened to the sermon, what do you think the Holy Spirit was already pointing out to you?
3. Practically speaking, how do we take every thought captive? What does that look like? What steps are involved? How do I challenge my own thinking?
4. Have you ever thought about the gentleness and lowliness of Jesus? As this is the description Jesus gives of Himself, how do these descriptive words surprise you? What words would you have chosen to describe Him? Why do you think Christ chose these words rather than a number of other descriptors?
5. How do you think Christians today are tempted to approach the world? If most of us would agree that gentleness is the best way, why do you think it's abandoned as quickly as it is? Is it a belief issue, an impulse issue, a character issue, etc.?
6. How have you seen spiritual weapons (Prayer, Faith, God's Word, Kindness, Gentleness and Humility, win battles you didn't think could be won?
7. Which spiritual weapons do you wield more deftly? Which could you use some additional practice utilizing?
8. How should we go about identifying strongholds in our life, both sin and thought strongholds? If they are so normal to us, and often invisible to us, how do we start breaking them down?

9. Are you putting yourself in positions to allow Christ to use God's Word, godly mentors, helpful study, etc. to attack the faulty arguments you hold? If so, how? If not, how would you start to open yourself up to these things?
10. Have you seen Christ already at work in your life in the areas of pride and your thoughts? How are you different already since choosing to walk with Christ? Where do you sense He's leading you now?
