Icebreaker:

Play a game of ‘telephone.’ Have someone come up with a short sentence and whisper it to the person next to you until it goes all the way around the room to see how it ends up.

Discussion Questions:

1. Paul mentions his imprisonment and how it has served to advance the gospel. What does this teach us about God's ability to work through challenging circumstances? =
2. How do you think the different motivations mentioned by Paul's detractors in preaching the gospel (envy, rivalry, goodwill) can impact the effectiveness of ministry?
3. What can we learn from Paul's attitude toward his critics and opponents in ministry as described in these verses?
4. Have you experienced situations where God turned a difficult circumstance into an opportunity for His work to advance? Share and discuss.
5. How can we navigate situations where people within the Church have differing motivations or approaches to ministry?
6. What role does rejoicing and celebrating the proclamation of Christ, even in the face of criticism, play in our own lives and in the life of the Church?
7. What does it look like to “boldly speak God’s word” like Paul did in our current situations? Tell of a time where you demonstrated boldness. How do Christians increase their level of boldness without being obnoxious?
8. In what ways can we overcome the temptation to be discouraged when faced with opposition or adversity in our Christian walk?
