October 22 – To Live is Christ

Phil. 1:19-30

Icebreaker:

If you had to come up with a funny motto for your life, what would it be?
What is your favorite 'motto' for a brand or product?

Discussion Questions:

1. Paul speaks about his expectation and hope that he will not be ashamed but will have courage. What are some sources of Christian courage in the face of trials? What are some moments in your life where you needed Christian courage?
2. In verse 21, Paul famously says, "To live is Christ, and to die is gain." What do you think he means by this, and how can we apply this perspective in our lives?
3. What does it mean to "strive side by side for the faith of the gospel" (verse 27)? How can we practically do this in our Christian walk?
4. How can we handle suffering and persecution with the same mindset and faith that Paul demonstrates in these verses? What does persecution even look like in today's culture?
5. In what ways can we "conduct ourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ" (verse 27) in our daily lives? What does the worthy life look like?
6. What does it mean to be citizens of heaven (verse 20)? How can this perspective impact our priorities and values on earth?
7. Share examples of situations where you've seen Christians come together to support and encourage each other during times of difficulty or persecution.
8. How can we maintain joy and unity within the body of Christ, even when faced with external challenges and suffering?
