



# Life Group Discussion Guide

## April 28 – 1 Corinthians 12 – The Gifts of the Body

### Icebreaker:

If you could live anywhere in the world for a year, where would it be?

### Optional

- Send out the link below to the members of your life group. Ask them to take the spiritual gifts assessment before coming to group or at the beginning of your group.

- Did anything surprise you about the results of this assessment? How does this assessment help you better understand your spiritual gifts?
- What ways is God calling you to use specific gifts to be a part of the body and serve Him?

### Discussion Questions:

1. As a group, read **1 Corinthians 12:4-27**. What stands out to you from this text? What stood out to you from the sermon this weekend?
2. Randy explained how this passage teaches us that we have been entrusted with spiritual gifts to use for a purpose.
  - a. How does this feel, knowing that God has entrusted with spiritual gifts?
  - b. How does this truth impact your sense of purpose or responsibility?
3. In this passage, Paul teaches that there is no hierarchy of gifts but that each gift is essential to the body.
  - a. Are there any gifts you tend to elevate above others? Do you ever find yourself jealous of other gifts?
  - b. How can you guard against valuing some gifts above others?

4. Randy mentioned four primary ways to discern our spiritual gifts: seeking the Lord through prayer and Scripture, diligently look for what Christ might see, try and experiment, accompany those who are serving.
  - a. Do you have experience with any of these means of discovering gifts? What have you found to be most effective in your own life when it comes to discovering your gifts?
  - b. Do you think you know what spiritual gifts God has given you in this season of your life?
  - c. What could you do to try and better discern what your spiritual gifts may be?
  
5. Everyone has been entrusted with a spiritual gift, and this passage teaches that each gift is greatly needed.
  - a. Do you feel like you are currently using your spiritual gifts to serve God?
  - b. Do you feel like there are gifts that you have that you are not using for God? How can you find ways to offer them to Him?
  - c. How does your spiritual gifting fit into the puzzle that shows Christ to the world?
  
6. Closing Commitments
  - a. How will you continue to pursue a deeper understanding of the spiritual gifts that God has given you?
  - b. As you look at your life, what can you do to keep from neglecting the spiritual gifts that you have been given?
  - c. How is God asking you to use your gifts to serve Him?
