April 7 – 1 Corinthians 8 – Prevailing in Unity

Icebreaker:

If you had to give a speech about any topic with only 15 minutes to prepare, what topic would you choose?

Discussion Questions:

1. Ask someone to read aloud **1 Corinthians 8** aloud.
 - What stands out to you from this text?
 - What stood out to you from the sermon on Sunday?
2. What does it mean for two people to do opposite things and still be pleasing to the Lord? How is this possible?
3. Can you think of any situations where you've encountered differing opinions or actions among believers regarding "Gray Areas" which are not explicitly addressed in Scripture? How did you navigate these differences?
4. Have you ever found yourself in a situation where you have been tempted by spiritual pride? What can you do to avoid spiritual pride?
5. Randy emphasized the danger of being mastered by our decisions. How can we guard against allowing our freedoms to become stumbling blocks or sources of bondage in our lives?
6. Paul warns against actions that could wound the conscience of our brothers and sisters in Christ. How can we balance our freedom in Christ with sensitivity to the convictions of others?
7. Have you ever experienced a situation where someone's actions, though permissible, caused harm or offense to others in the church? How was it resolved, or how could it have been handled better?

8. Read **1 Corinthians 8:3**. How can we ensure that our choices are motivated by love for God and others rather than selfish desires or personal preferences?
