



Life Group Discussion Guide

May 12 – 1 Corinthians 13 – The Way of Love and the Church

Icebreaker (options):

- If Christian love had a theme song, what do you think it would be and why?
- If you could choose any fictional duo to represent the epitome of Christian love, who would it be and why?

Discussion Questions:

1. Ask someone to read aloud **1 Corinthians 13** aloud.
 - What stands out to you from this text?
 - What stood out to you from the sermon on Sunday?
2. Reflecting on your experience of love from infancy to adulthood, what is one significant way your understanding of love has changed over the years?
3. In your opinion, what are some common misconceptions about love that society promotes, and how do they contrast with the scripture's definition of love?
4. Discuss the concept of love not rejoicing in wrongdoing but rejoicing with the truth. How can we balance love and truth in our relationships, especially when dealing with difficult situations or conflicts?
5. The sermon uses two metaphors: love that celebrates wrongdoing is compared to a swamp while God's love is compared to a river. How does this analogy resonate with you, and what implications does it have for how we express love in our lives?
6. Share your thoughts on the idea that love is an end in itself. How does this perspective change the way we view our spiritual gifts, accomplishments, and pursuits in life?
7. Review the story of Mary Magdalene at the tomb and her initial inability to recognize Jesus. Have you ever experienced a similar moment of realization or clarity in your own life?

8. How can we move beyond the sometimes-inadequate shadows of earthly love and into the greater love of God (with our families, in our Life Group, whole church, and beyond)?
