

Life Group Discussion Guide

July 21 – James 3 – Real Faith and Its Words

Icebreaker:

Tell of a time someone spoke healing words over you. What was so impactful about those words or the timing of them?

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Ask someone to read James 3 aloud.
- 2. Knowing the impact of words in our own life, for good or for bad, why do we all seem to buy into the delusion that our own words are of little consequence, that they're "just words?"
- 3. Have you ever thought about the idea that your words are not something you do but a revelation of who you are? How do we become people who own what's in our hearts rather than passively dismiss the revelation as a mistake and something other than an indicator of our deeper spirit?
- 4. Many of us probably have a list in our minds of poor word habits. But there's also probably poor word habits that are not on our own list mostly because it's become acceptable to us, or so commonplace we don't think twice about it. What might some of those poor word habits be? (Examples: yelling, whiny, complaining, passive-aggressive, sarcastic, crude, etc.)
- 5. Randy mentioned two ways we pretend our words are not "us". What truths do we need to dwell on to not only confront, but overcome these lies?
 - a. Our words are what other people draw out of us, essentially that it's other people's fault.
 - b. Our words are from something other than me. It's my anger talking, or my tiredness, etc.
- 6. How do we grieve over our sin? What are the steps to repentance and healing as laid out by James and other passages of Scripture?
- 7. As a challenge, pick a verse from today's passage and memorize it this week. Post it in prominent places in your home and ask the Holy Spirit to partner with you to tame your tongue. Make it a family discussion and challenge to help each other in how you speak with one another.
