



Life Group Discussion Guide

November 19 – Trust the Covenant – Nehemiah 12

Icebreaker:

1. How can naturally kind and generous people prevent others from taking advantage of them?
2. What's the most 80s sounding song that isn't from the 80s?

Discussion Questions:

3. What stood out to you from the sermon this weekend?
4. In Nehemiah 12, we see a careful organization of people and resources for the dedication of the walls. How can we apply principles of stewardship in organizing and managing resources within our church community?
5. The dedication ceremony involved the active participation of various groups, including priests, Levites, and singers. What are some ways that you have seen various gifts being used at Legacy in unique and inspiring ways?
6. Reflect on the dedication of the city gates in Nehemiah 12. How can we view our personal and communal "gates" (areas of influence and responsibility) as opportunities for stewardship?
7. Discuss the concept of tithes and offerings in Nehemiah 12 and how it relates to our modern understanding of financial stewardship. How has tithing regularly affected your relationship with God, the church, and others?

8. Nehemiah 12 mentions the purification of priests and people. In what ways can we connect the concept of spiritual purity to our stewardship of God's resources, both tangible and intangible?
9. Bryan used an analogy of a chair in his sermon. With that in mind, what's preventing you from resting more deeply in the chair of generosity?
10. Explore the idea of legacy and inheritance found in Nehemiah 12. How does a focus on stewardship impact the legacy we leave for future generations in our church and community?
