



Life Group Discussion Guide

January 25: Daniel 3 --- The Fires of Life

Icebreaker:

Describe the hottest environment you've ever experienced, e.g., "I used to work in roofing during the summers."

Discussion Questions:

Every group is different! As you prepare, choose the questions that best fit your group, focusing on those that spark meaningful conversation. Don't rush—depth is better than distance. Trust the Holy Spirit to lead your discussion!

Big idea: Genuine Faith is revealed in trials.

Read Daniel 3:4-6

- "Faith is easy when obedience doesn't cost you anything." Where have you noticed the difference between *convenient faith* and *real faith* in your own life?
- **Read 1 John 2:15-17.** Daniel grasped the same truths John shares. Where do you still have room to grow: Lust of the eyes (access to fun, relaxation, pleasure), materialism, or ego?

Read Daniel 3:7-12

- Society has standards that can align with "Christian behavior," but don't always. Describe a time you have had to negotiate when society's patterns were no longer aligned with Christlikeness.
- Where might God be calling you to quietly but firmly refuse to bow without being obnoxious about it? Think about these life spheres: Family, work, friends, personal time

Read Daniel 3:13-18

- The men said, "God is able... but even if He does not..." Why can the "even if" part be harder than the "God is able" part? What life situations are you trying to live out this same prayer or heart disposition?

Read Daniel 3:19-30

- The sermon described three ways God delivers: from the fire, through the fire, or by the fire. Which one best describes your current season? What might God be burning away or building up in you?
- In the furnace, the ropes burned off but the men didn't. What "ropes" (habits, fears, dependencies, false hopes) might God be using a trial to remove from your life?

Reflection and Application:

Courageous hope is rooted in confidence in God's character, not certainty about outcomes. What does it look like for you this week to live as someone who truly believes Jesus has the final word?
