Life Group Discussion Guide

February 8: Daniel 6 --- Daniel and the Lions' Den

Icebreakers:

What's a rule (written or unwritten) that you've had the hardest time following in your life? Why?

When something stressful or unfair happens, what's your first instinct – fix it, vent about it, avoid it, or pray?

Discussion Questions:

Every group is different! As you prepare, choose the questions that best fit your group, focusing on those that spark meaningful conversation. Don't rush—depth is better than distance. Trust the Holy Spirit to lead your discussion!

1. Read Daniel 6:1-9

- a. What stands out to you from this passage?
- b. What stood out to you from the sermon on Sunday?

2. Integrity: Read Daniel 6:3-5

- a. How did Daniel's integrity allow God to position Daniel where He wanted him?
- b. How could God use your integrity to transform the world around you?
- c. Where do you feel most tempted to separate your faith from your everyday life? (work, school, relationships, online, etc.) What can it look like for you to pursue a life of integrity in these areas?

3. Prayer: Read Daniel 6:10

- a. When Daniel found out about the edict instead of fighting it, the first thing he did was pray. How are you tempted to fight when something bad happens? What would it look like for you to turn to prayer instead?
- b. Daniel prayed "just as he had done before." If you are being honest, how would you describe your current prayer habits? What is one way you would like to grow in your prayer life this week?

c. **Read Ephesians 6:10-13.** John Piper described prayer as a wartime walkie-talkie, not a domestic intercom. In what ways might you be living like we are in spiritual peacetime rather than war? What would it look like for you to use prayer as a "wartime walkie-talkie?"

4. **Faith Read Daniel 6:19-26**

- How did Daniel's faith glorify God and let others know about Him?
- Can you think of a time when you had to trust in God's character when you didn't know or didn't like out outcome? What helped? What made it difficult?
- Read Psalm 22:19-21.** How does knowing that Jesus entered "the lions' den" for us change the way we face trials, fear, and obedience today?

5. What is one intentional step you will take this week to live a life marked by integrity, prayer, and faith?

6. How can we as a group pray specifically for each other, for Ramadan, and for Barko? Is there someone or something that we as a group will all commit to pray for this week?
