



# Life Group Discussion Guide

## February 22: Daniel 7-12 --- The Plain Things of Daniel's Visions

### Icebreakers:

What's the strangest or most confusing dream you've ever had?

If you could know one thing about the future with absolute certainty, what would you want to know, and why?

### Discussion Questions:

*Every group is different! As you prepare, choose the questions that best fit your group, focusing on those that spark meaningful conversation. Don't rush—depth is better than distance. Trust the Holy Spirit to lead your discussion!*

#### 1. Read Daniel 7:1-15 (1-28 if time permits)

- a. What is going on in this passage?
  - i. Ask the "W" questions about this passage: Who? What? Where? When? Why?
- b. What does this passage teach us about God and Jesus?
- c. Read verses 13 and 14 again. What is taking place?
- d. What thoughts and feelings do these verses stir in you?

#### 2. In Babylon, Daniel saw kings and kingdoms rise and fall. As followers of Jesus Christ, we are citizens of a kingdom not of this world. (John 18:36)

- a. How do earthly kingdoms steal our hearts?
- b. What examples did Daniel give us of living faithfully in exile?
- c. In your own life, when does God's kingdom feel close? When does it feel far away?

### 3. Read Daniel 12:1-13

- a. What promises do you see in these verses? Positive or negative?
- b. At the conclusion of this book we, like Daniel, are left without answers to some questions. What clear answers do we have? How do we respond?
- c. As we conclude this study of the book of Daniel, share how you have been encouraged, challenged, or moved in your faith in God.
